SCCS offers a comprehensive four-year college-preparatory education. There are seven 50-minute class periods each day. Class sizes average between 18-28 students and there are approximately 153 students in our high school program. All courses successfully completed are worth five credits per semester. Courses are approved through the UC a-g system. Dual Credit courses have received approval through the partner Universities. The school year is 177 days long.

In that case both courses are listed, but the credit recovery course is the only grade calculated into the GPA.
